Look before you lock.

Children's bodies overheat easily, and infants and children under 3 years old are at greatest risk for heat-related illness.

- A child's body absorbs more heat on a hot day than an adult's does.***
- Heatstroke begins when the core body temperature reaches about 104 degrees and the thermoregulatory system is overwhelmed.***

What you can do to prevent leaving a child behind:

- Put your purse/billfold, briefcase, computer/iPad/Cell Phone/Pager and keys to the office in the back seat so you will be able to check for a child!***
- Be Sure that You Look Before You Lock!!!***
- Have a contract with your childcare provider to call you if your child does not arrive when expected***
- If you see an unattended child – call 911 immediately!***
