Kansas City, MO- Mid America Immunization Coalition (MAIC) will host their 13th annual Immunization Symposium, "Exploring Challenges and Opportunities" on Friday, June 27, 2014 at the Ritz Charles Conference Center in Overland Park, Kansas.
